



## Copp's Buildall Home Renovation Credit Program 2009

Copp's Buildall is joining the Government of Canada in helping you create your dream home through renovations and improvements in 2009!

Copp's is proud to announce a 5% in-store credit, on project purchases, offered to those homeowners who qualify for and participate in the Home Renovation Tax Credit(HRTC) program recently announced by the Government of Canada.

How does this work?

You simply purchase materials through Copp's for your home renovation project (which must qualify under the HRTC program) under an assigned customer code created specifically to track your total purchases. Upon completion of your project, Copp's will issue you an in-store credit in the amount of 5% of your total pre-tax purchases. This credit can be used to purchase material within any one of Copp's four local locations.

Who is eligible?

Those who qualify for the Government HRTC program will be eligible to participate in Copp's program. An information sheet on the HRTC program is attached and is also available on our website at [www.coppsbuildall.com](http://www.coppsbuildall.com). Your total purchases must be a minimum of \$1000.00 to qualify. Typical projects that qualify are; renovating a kitchen, bathroom, or basement; new carpet or hardwood floors; building an addition, deck, fence or retaining wall; painting the interior or exterior of your home; and/or resurfacing your driveway. Any materials you purchase for the purpose of one of the above projects will fit within Copp's program as well. Purchase of tools or cleaning supplies will not qualify under the HRTC program and thus will not be accepted as part of Copp's program.

How do I sign-up?

Copp's will require the following from each person in the program;

1. Fill out a "Loyal Customer" form at your local Copp's branch.
2. Fill out a "Home Renovation Program Application" sheet at your local Copp's branch.

\*\*Simply visit your local Copp's Buildall and inform one of our sales professionals that you are interested in taking part in the "Home Renovation Credit Program" and they will assist you in filling out the one-page forms. Once you have completed the forms we will quote your project and begin the process of providing you with the necessary materials to make improvements to your home.

Upon completion of your project you must notify your Copp's sales professional that you are complete. We will then calculate and issue your in-store credit based upon your total pre-tax purchases for the project.

This program will be offered from February 22nd to December 31st, 2009. Your in-store credit must be used within 1 year of issuance.
